

Hello Uke Lover!

If you follow the Play Along schedule, as designed, you'll soon be sounding good on the uke, so I urge you, please print this document out **right now** and keep it handy, perhaps right next to your uke.



I recommend you do on average 3 of the lessons per week. You can do more than one lesson per day but I encourage you to do at least one lesson on 3 different days of the week (e.g. Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday) - spreading lessons out like this will really slice time off your learning curve!

When you complete a lesson simply check off the box on the schedule then move onto the next scheduled lesson.

Other Useful Info For Using the Lessons

When repeating lessons, you may want to fast forward the video and focus on the play-along sections. To save time, you can make notes on this Play Along Schedule to indicate the exact times of exercises you want to repeat.

Some days, you will probably want to rewind the video and repeat a particular exercise multiple times until you feel confident.

If you notice you are having a challenging time with a particular technique, it's fine to move on to the next video, but please make a note on this Play Along Schedule; then consistently come back until you have mastered that technique.

The art of getting good fast is to identify a weakness and then regularly come back to practice until that weakness becomes a strength.
